## Hercules Street Park to go green ...in more ways than one

With more than 16,000 new plants and a recycled water irrigation system to come, the \$10 million Hercules Street Park upgrade is set to green up Northshore.

Hercules Street Park is designed to become an outdoor recreation haven, with barbecues, picnic areas, a children's playground, a water play facility, an off-leash dog park and walking paths that will remain fully lit at night.

And while 16,000 new plants ensure Hercules Street Park will be a shady, lush outdoor space for visitors and locals alike, the plants will also create a pleasant outlook for commuters along Kingsford Smith Drive and anyone entering the Northshore precinct.

In our hot Queensland summers – and likely many of our warm spring and autumn days too – the water play area will be a huge drawcard for



the Northshore precinct. The thoughtful design of the park includes a system to collect and recycle the water from the water play facility.

“Reusing the water to ensure the plants and grass stay alive is a fantastic use of our resources,” said Cameron Dick, the Minister for State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning.

JMac Constructions, appointed by Economic Development Queensland, commenced the upgrade works at Hercules Street Park back in January. When the works are completed (prior to Christmas 2019, weather permitting), Hercules Street Park will grow Northshore's reputation as one of Brisbane's popular outdoor recreation destinations.

## QUT landscape architecture students honour Northshore's history to envision its future

The Monkey Bar at Eat Street Northshore recently displayed futuristic visions of Northshore riverside by hosting the 'Northshore 2030 Studio Exhibition'.

To picture the future of Northshore's river landscape, we turned to the future of landscape architecture. 50 second-year QUT landscape architecture students were recently given a unique learning and professional development opportunity: create a vision for the future of Brisbane's largest urban waterfront renewal project.

The themes of 'engagement with the river', 'historic landscape' and 'heritage fabric' inspired designs that were futuristic yet connected to the natural landscape. Ten finalists were selected for the exhibition, and their designs included an artificial sandbar and river viewing platform, tidal gardens with a boardwalk and wetlands experience, and bird-friendly sculptures-come-wind turbines to power Northshore.

The project also encouraged community feedback via online voting to determine the favourite student concept. Voting closed on the 12 April, 2019, and we are happy to

celebrate this year's People's Choice Award' recipient: Jose Gutierrez Hincapie.

In Jose's piece 'The Nest Pavilion', visitors can enjoy their own 'nest': a relaxation pavilion created from Northshore's original wharf timbers. Echoing the nests of the shorebirds that visit Northshore's historic storage tank today, the piece invites visitors to settle in and watch as the light changes across the timber's

rich, history-etched forms. It offers a relaxing vantage point to take in the ever-changing sky and scenery of the Brisbane River and Northshore.

'Student exhibition concepts are not guaranteed to be implemented at Northshore, but may be considered in the future. This event was presented by QUT Creative Industries, RPS Group and Vee Design, supported by Northshore.

## TeamArrow racing into the future

Northshore’s own solar racing team, the TeamArrow Racing Association, is preparing to join the Bridgestone World Solar Challenge (BWSC19) this October.

The course will see the team undertake a challenging five days of sun-powered driving across the outback – 3,021 kilometres from Darwin to Adelaide. But there’s more to this challenge than simply a race.

The BWSC19 is helping build a future where solar cars are in everyday use by inspiring Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) students to progress solar technology. The challenge will judge not only each car’s ability to complete the course, but their efficiency along the way.

TeamArrow will be racing in the Cruiser Class, where the solar cars entered are designed for practical use with two or more seats. Teams in this class will be asked to perform some of the everyday tasks expected of current on-road vehicles, including reverse parallel parking and picking up groceries.



TeamArrow has begun modifying their two-seater solar-electric sports car, the ArrowSTF, ahead of the BWSC19. Keep an eye out for the team in the Eat Street Northshore carpark as they test their vehicle.
